Title and abstract of the intended presentation

EURO 2012 as an impuls for overcoming the underdevelopment of transport system in Poland

Apart from adequate sport infrastructure a good quality transport system is crucial to organize an event of UEFA Cup rank. Relatively short time remaining to realize the necessary investments requires a rethinking development priorities and efficient actions. This challenge is particularly difficult in conditions of Poland, which until now has to tackle the delays of development in relation to countries 'Old Europe'.

Thanks to the perspective of hosting the championships a large group of stakeholders has been mobilized to accelerate the implementation of the investments in the field of motorways, railways, airports as well as local transportation. The vast majority of upcoming investments – with the importance of national, regional and local rank - were already included in development plans, but in further future.

The change of priorities is being followed by change of the legal and organizational issues. The most important legal change is the adoption of special act on organization of UEFA EURO 2012, which causes changes in 20 other legal acts dedicated to e.i. public-private partnerships and spatial planning. Organizational changes relate mostly to forming a number of national and local special-purpose investment vehicles.

The financial resources for the realization of implementation of the EURO 2012 master plan come mostly from the state budget and the budgets of local and regional self-governments. However, in case of transport infrastructure - despite its additionality - the EU funds play an important role. Those funds are being distributed within the Operational Programme Infrastructure and Environment, the Operational Programme Innovative Economy and Regional Operational Programmes.

Public-private partnership does not play a major role here, being confined mostly to supporting the infrastructure of tourism. This is due to the fact that the previous imperfect act on PPP and has been changed too late and private investors are still very restrained in business cooperation with public sector.
