A question how to position and evaluate social capital (SC) of a company, country or region has come to predominate the debate over society and governance. We suggest to consider SC as both a static resource (*e.g.* SC value of Microsoft at the end of a quarter, say, Sept. 30, 2009) or as a dynamic process (*e.g.* SC of a team of experts working on a given project). We think that proximity plays an inestimable role in the analysis of SC, be it at a company or country level. Abstracts of both theoretical and practical papers should be send to me not later than **January 15, 2010**. The decision of acceptance will be sent by February 15. The authors of the accepted papers will be invited to participate at the organization of special session(s) and possible round table discussion.
