Special Round Table at ERSA 2010

Regionalisation and Decentralisation in Central Eastern Europe have been introduced into the political debates and state realities between the poles of transformation of post-Stalinist society's 1989 and EU accession 2004/07. Both matters are perceived in a number of CEE countries as closed matters, the latter (regionalisation) to a large extent introduced from outside.

A panel of invited speakers (TBA) will discuss:

- What is the status of the political discourse in CEE countries with regard to Decentralisation and Regionalisation today?
- Do we see national autonomous discourses on regionalisation and multi-level government that qualify for independent problem solving?
- How do forward looking concepts (post 2013) look like?
