State-of-the-art in spatial computable general equilibrium modelling

In the last decade Spatial Computable General Equilibrium (SCGE) models have become a key tool in the evaluation of the economic effects of various regional policy measures. Their application started from evaluating indirect effects of transport infrastructure investments at a regional level. Nowadays these models are also applied to other research questions including evaluation of effects of European Cohesion Policy, regional planning policies, climate change, natural disasters, terrorist attacks etc.

Many of existing SCGE models incorporate the features of New Economic Geography. They also model linkages between the regions via trade in goods and services, commuting, migration and investments. Most of the existing applied SCGE models are static and do not capture the dynamics of investments. In the last years there has been several applications where both recursive and full inter-temporal dynamics have been implemented with the SCGE framework. This gives room for even more interesting model simulations and conclusions.
