

Special Round Table at ERSA 2010:

Round table with winners of the Global Award for Entrepreneurship Research

Since its inception in 1996 the *Global Award for Entrepreneurship Research* has become firmly established as the foremost global award for research on entrepreneurship. This Prize is awarded annually and it consists of the statuette "The Hand of God", created by Swedish Sculptor Carl Milles, and a Prize sum of 100,000 euros.

The organizations behind the Prize are the Swedish Entrepreneurship Forum (Entreprenörskapsforum), the Swedish Agency for Economic and Regional Growth (Tillväxtverket) and the Research Institute of Industrial Economics (IFN).

In this Special Round Table a number of Award winners share their experiences from the frontiers of entrepreneurship research.
